Comments:	<p>Sir/Madam</p> <p>I wish to object to the proposals to build a major distribution centre to the south-east of junction 17 of the M4 with the following concerns:</p> <p>Traffic:</p> <p>The B4122 (a country road) currently struggles in peak times to support traffic. Building the distribution centre will exasperate this with LGV vehicles.</p> <p>We already experience one to two mile tailbacks on the M4 with traffic exiting J17. Again, this centre will add to this dangerous problem.</p> <p>The recycling centre regularly causes a bottleneck on the B4122. More LGV traffic on this road will increase that bottleneck.</p> <p>Rain water and flooding:</p> <p>There is a danger that rain water from 1000000 square feet of concrete used to build the centre will overwhelm the brook to the South of the B4122. This brook regularly floods and causes local traffic problems.</p> <p>Disruption:</p> <p>Traffic problems will be multiplied during the development phase of this centre causing more congestion and delays.</p> <p>Employment:</p> <p>Currently there are no listed customers for this centre, therefore, it is unknown if the local area will benefit from its potential employment opportunities.</p> <p>Employment traffic will add to the congestion. There is limited scope for employees to utilise public transport to get to the site. Also there are no footpaths and cycling is dangerous on the A350 and B4122.</p>
