Comments:	<p>Dear Mr Burman,</p> <p>I have an interest in Outline Planning Application 17/03417/OUT as a resident of the nearby village of Sutton Benger and, having reviewed a large number of the supporting documents supplied on the Wiltshire Council website, would like to object to it.</p> <p>This objection is made on the basis of:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The risk of groundwater contamination as highlighted by the Environment Agency. 2. Concerns about light pollution and the requirement for additional public transport facilities to be provided as raised by Chippenham Council; the latter of which is unlikely to be forthcoming in the current economic climate. 3. The inevitable noise pollution that a warehouse site will generate, from both the running of generators and the coming and going of heavy goods vehicles. This issue is mentioned by the Environmental Control and Protection response. 4. The fact that (according to the Highways Agency) up to 600 heavy goods vehicles a day may need to access the site through the M4, J17 / B4122 interface. This area is ill suited for this sort of traffic as it is already heavily congested in the morning/evening and at times when the adjacent recycling centre is open. 5. The impact on the natural beauty and biodiversity of the area, in line with concerns highlighted by Natural England. 6. The lack of consultation with local people as a consequence of the ongoing Parish Council elections in both Kington Langley and Sutton Benger, both of which are village communities which will be significantly affected by this proposal and should be properly consulted. 7. The risks of further flooding, in an area that is already a catchment for the River Avon to the East of Sutton Benger. In particular, the high street of Sutton Benger floods particularly easily after even a very slight downpour, a fact evidenced by the very poor state of repair of the main road which has been worn away by a combination of heavy rainfall and traffic. <p>As a result of all of these factors, I simply cannot support the planning application in its current form and believe that it should be rejected as being proposed in an unsuitable site.</p> <p>Yours sincerely,</p> <p>Mark Dingle</p>
