Comments:	<p>I strongly object to this proposed massive development. We have lived at the neighbouring property South Sea Farm for 27 years. The development is completely overwhelming in scale, will be visible from miles away (eg. Cherhill White Horse and Lansdowne Monument ) will dominate our house and will ruin the rural area. The noise, increased traffic and light will be intolerable and to allow the destruction of ancient hedgerows, oak trees and habitat, so much of which has already disappeared across the country, is appalling .</p> <p>Days Lane and Kington Langley will be used as rat runs and anyone riding, walking or cycling will be at risk.</p> <p>It seems to be premature, opportunistic and badly researched. The Employment land study is out of date. IF there is a need for such a proposal and unemployment in this area (which I believe there isn't) why can't a more suitable brown land site be considered (e.g. the hundred's of acres at Hullavington where Dyson will be building). The A 350 and B4122 are currently extremely busy roads and this proposal along with the residential developments around Chippenham (Rawlings Farm, Barrow Farm and others (if approved) and Dyson at Hullavington will gridlock at junction 17 and put unacceptable pressure on them.</p> <p>Does Chippenham really want to have this as its GATEWAY?</p>
