Comments:	<p>My points for objecting to this proposed scheme are as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -This proposed development in an otherwise unspoilt rural area would irreparably damage the 'gateway to Chippenham' and have a hugely negative impact on the essentially rural character of the approach to Chippenham from the north. - I use the B4122 to access the M4 on a regular basis. This road is already congested at peak times and I believe not able to support the increased traffic generated by this proposed scheme. - The surrounding area is particularly prone to flooding and vulnerable to changes in the river system and catchment area. I believe the proposed development involves re-routing a river, which could have far reaching negative impact. - There are far more suitable areas around Swindon, as yet undeveloped, with a higher demand for storage and distribution than the proposed site. Development should be concentrated on these sites, rather than the unspoilt rural area of the proposed scheme, with a secondary demand.
