Comments:	<p>We are concerned mainly about the process of demolition and replacement. We would like to be reassured that access to the site will not endanger people or animals walking on the public footpath and our shared driveway. We would ask that consideration of an alternative temporary access to the site is considered - possibly across the fields to the main road. This would minimise the number of lorries and other vehicles using the single lane road leading to our shared driveway and the public footpath.</p> <p>We are also concerned about the potential for noise and disturbance during the works - We would like assurance that work will only occur only during normal weekday working hours - especially during summer months. The proposed new build will require piling and we are concerned about the potential for excessive noise and dust.</p> <p>Finally we are concerned that the height of the new house will affect our privacy in our garden / swimming pool area. Currently we are not overlooked by the existing house. This is a comment rather than objection but we would like our concern for long term privacy noted.</p>
