Comments	<p>The development will be out of keeping with the other dwellings from Hobbs Hill to Longlease Farm in Main Street. All the existing buildings are Grades 1 or 2, apart from the school, and provide an indication of the development of the village from the 1500s. They would have a deleterious effect on the the historiic value and the look of this part of Keevil. New properties, however they are faced, will look completely out of place and stand out inappropriately.</p> <p>The site is adjoining Keevil School which already creates problems with vehicle movements and parking in the morning and late afternoon, which go all the way past the the corner, and at other times according to the events organised by the school when their is a large influx of parents and visitors. This is already a pressure point particularly with the arrival and departure of coaches delivering and collecting the children and the large agricultural vehicles passing through the village. Access to the houses will be difficult at these times.</p>
