Planning Application by Church Farm for the building of 2 dwellings on the land between Little Tallboys and Church Farm on Main Street, Keevil

We strongly object to the above planning application on the following grounds:-

This development lies within the heart of the Conservation area of Keevil. It would be totally out of character being next to Little Tallboys, the most striking and oldest house on the street.

These ancient properties need the present wide spaces between each other. It would be absolutely criminal to see any of these beautiful old buildings hedged in with new builds.

In 1999 an application for a single property 12 meters from Little Tallboys was rejected by West Wiltshire District Council and was also refused after Appeal by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

The current Application has the plot 2 house, 15 meters from Little Tallboys and with two windows overlooking Little Tallboys there is a big privacy issue.

Parts of Keevil are locked in a time gone by and the character and atmosphere surrounding our oldest buildings must be preserved. Yes, life evolves, but if we don't continue to preserve what we have in a sympathetic way, our remaining historical heritage will be lost for ever.
