	<p>Until 3 years ago, I was a resident in Keevil, living almost immediately opposite Little Talboys, in a Grade 2 listed, timbered and thatched cottage. I was involved in the design of the VDS. The area of the proposed development is in the heart of the most historic and beautiful part of Keevil and, although the village suffers from a paucity of small and affordable housing, the VDS was clear that every effort should be made to retain this historic and beautiful area. I believe the Parish Council is gravely mistaken in its support for the project, being as the proposed housing is modern, out of keeping and fundamentally in direct contradiction with the VDS, which it was so pleased to endorse before publication. A further consideration is the potential addition of yet more vehicles - certainly 2 and probably 4 - adding to the already dangerously congested area from school runs and other parked cars. In the UK, we struggle to reconcile the need for housing and the need for future generations to have access to our history, both at National and local level, and is regrettable that, too often, immediate advantage wins over long term and unfortunate consequences. I am sorry for Mr and Mrs Banfield if the application is rejected but, if I had still been living in Keevil, I would have vehemently opposed the application. I recommend strongly that it is rejected.</p>
