	<p>I wish to object to this planning application.</p> <p>In my view the Village Design Statement (VDS) is a set of principles to adhere to. It respects historic patterns, preservation of a conservation area and protection of open spaces. This proposed development would ignore all three principles and surely set a precedent for future similar proposals in the village.</p> <p>In addition, I have serious concerns about exacerbating the daily school traffic chaos we suffer. Each school day we experience a dangerous logjam along 200 yards of Main Street and Church Walk, for an hour in the morning then a repeat in the mid afternoon. Planners need to come and observe this to appreciate how congested and dangerous the area becomes. The prospect of an additional 6 vehicles, i.e. 3 per house, with at least 4 parked regularly on Main Street would make the congestion even worse. If there is ever a call for an emergency vehicle at that time of day there could be serious consequences from delay and obstruction.</p> <p>Finally, I must comment on what I see as a contradictory response from the Parish Council. They support the application yet incredibly believe the VDS should be observed and wish no precedent set for further infilling. If this application is approved surely any and all future proposals elsewhere in Keevil must also be approved.</p>
