Comments:	<p>This is the letter I sent to Peter Fuller in June.</p> <p>I have seen the above Planning Application and have several concerns where I think it will impact on the local community and environment.</p> <p>It appears to be a large development, many more dwellings than are needed to cross finance the restoration and conversion to flats of Courtfield house and which entails the loss of most of the trees and wildlife. We have recently lost six trees in Trowbridge Park to aid development of St. George's Works. Should this be allowed to happen?</p> <p>I notice there are 40 plus parking spaces for cars and the suggestion that there would be fewer traffic movements than when the school had 47 pupils in 2009. A friend did a survey on Monday, 18th June from 8.30 to 9.30 and found there were 235 going down towards the Surgery and 103 coming up. Another count from 3.45 to 4.45 showed 236 downward and 115 upwards on a no through road. Other developments are granted or applied for : Court Mills, 7 town houses, 21 houses on McDonagh Court, 2 on the corner of Ashton Street and Polebarn Rd., several flats in the old Carpenters Arms. Should these not be taken into account when considering the impact on pollution levels in a very small area as well as on what is a single track road due to car parking?</p> <p>I also worry that Lovemead Surgery will become even more overwhelmed that it already is by the massive influx which will come about if all these applications are granted. Surely consideration should be given to the local population before allowing what appears to be a profiteering exercise of a piece of land that was bought with no planning permission, purely on speculation.</p>
