Comments:	<p>I object to the applicant's case for 'change of use' of the Three Horseshoes .</p> <p>As a family we regularly visited the pub whilst run by the previous tenant. It was only when the final tenant took over that we reduced our visits. If a pub is run well with good food, we, our family and friends would definitely support it. There is a long history attached to the Three Horseshoes and it should remain part of our village.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · There is currently no pub in Burbage selling food, so many villagers would love a pub that served good food. In particular, as a wheelchair user and unable to drive, I am not able to travel independently to other pubs due to the very poor bus routes and taxis being too expensive. The Three Horseshoes could offer a valuable service to everyone, of all ages, in the village especially those who are unable to drive. <p>It was mentioned that there is not enough passing trade, but this is not accurate. On the numerous occasions that we attended, we often saw walkers, cyclists and holiday makers, all passing through the area and wanting a break. If the pub were run successfully, there is enough trade for it to be sustainable.</p> <p>I believe that the reasons given by the applicant for changing the use are not valid and that it would be detrimental to community life to lose our only food serving pub. Therefore the application should be rejected.</p>
