	<p>Given the factual errors in the application, it would have been nice (although would not have supported their case) if there had been some research to explain the decline in barrelage and hence the supposed case why the pub is not viable. The reported lack of investment by Wadworth, the illness of the former tenant's wife (who had run the pub for over 20 years), the price differential when the White Hart opened and the "quirkiness"s of the last tenants (which affected trade) all contributed to the decline. With a little investment, the right landlords, provision of good pub food and support from the village, the Three Horseshoes would become a viable and welcome business in the community. To approve this application would deny a thriving and vibrant village of a wonderful, viable community asset.</p>
