I feel that Saxon Rise is at capacity for car parking and can not take any more. By taking the garages down and using existing parking spaces for road access and extra housing means that vehicles will have to park elsewhere. But where? Cars and vans are already parking on kerbs, pavements and grass verges. So there is the prospect of creating new spaces by digging up the grass and taking away green spaces.
