Comments:	<p>I strongly object to this planning application on the following basis:-</p> <p>1) Aster tenants and residents at Riverbourne Road were not consulted despite us being affected by the planning</p> <p>2) The play park was built for the families of Saxon Rise and Riverbourne Road when the Riverbourne development was built yet they have not been consulted or taken into consideration.</p> <p>3) Serious safety implications to more traffic being routed to more dwellings in front of the play park.</p> <p>4) Loss of recreational space for children which is already very limited.</p> <p>5) You state the green area around the park is used for anti-social behaviour by children which is untrue.</p> <p>6) Parking is a serious issue already, a further loss of parking and more houses. Residents are advised to use the overspill parking in that area which will no longer be available. Currently Riverbourne has 1.5 spaces allocated per house, with some residents having 4 cars per household as the children get older and cars are needed to get to and from work in rural locations and with a lack of public transport.</p> <p>7) Garages: prices have been increased recently in an attempt to become too expensive to rent and therefore meaning they are not required.</p> <p>8) local residents from Collingbourne are in fact occupying the garages therefore if they are removed there will be even more cars requiring parking</p> <p>9) Impact on schools. The local school is already full to maximum capacity and therefore bringing more families into the area will put even more strain on the schools</p> <p>10) Impact on Drs and hospitals. No additional provision has been made to increase Drs surgeries and with the increase of the population due to swell with the influx of Military families this will also add to the impact by having more housing in the area.</p> <p>11) During adverse weather conditions cars have to park in the Cadley Road this will increase with more housing and poses a serious risk of an accident due to lack of visibility and that is it used by agricultural vehicles and as a short cut for local traffic to and from HUNGERFORD</p>
