Please withdraw this application. The school will consider a higher wall to safe guard the children ... however not sure they can afford to do this amount of work and I am not convinced this is the right approach.

It appears safety and cost reality is not a planning concern these days ?

Fencing in this location will not detract from the conservation area or harm the listed building ... the school has its own character (also having existing bow top fencing to the entrance).

The school has a few 'modern' extensions two being flat roofed with a **rubberised material and UPVC trims** (given approval by WC I assume) ... the modern fencing we felt was in keeping with the school feel yet **RETAINING** the old stone low level wall which preserves an aging feature of the village.

The transparency of the fence allowed the open feel to be retained.

I know and understand that there are many high stone boundary walls along Main Street, but there are no other modern schools !! So our proposal should have been looked on favourably or at the very least Russell could of recommended a fencing type, which provides safety and security, that he would be happy with ... perhaps he can comment further please and make any recommendations if he would re-consider the fence option??
